Foliar surface of about 110 cms

CARIGNAN PLOT OF VINEYARD

Surface: 0.9 hectares
Ground: Muddy, Clayey, Sandy
Planted in 1965
Short size: Old fashioned "Gobelet" size

MERLOT PLOT OF VINEYARD

Surface: 0.9 hectares
Ground: Muddy, Clayey
Planted in 2002
Royat cordon pruning
Trellising on wire at 60 cms from the ground
Foliar surface of about 100 cms

GRENACHE PLOT OF VINEYARD

Surface: 0.9 hectares
Ground: Muddy, Clayey, Sandy
Planted in 2011
Royat cordon pruning
Trellising on wire at 60 cms from the ground
Foliar surface of about 120 cms

Thinning out the leaves around the clusters of grapes of Syrah and Grenache.

Removal of water-shoot from the Merlot

Manual harvest for Carignan.

Harvest at optimum maturity.

Fermentation and maceration under pomace in cement tank for each type of grape, until the end of the malolactic fermentation.

Then maturing in a "floating lid" vat (closed), separating each variety of grapes.

Blending of the cuvées, the month of March following the harvest to prepare for bottling according to the lunar calendar.

Pierre Talayrach is a passionate winegrower and high standards are not an empty word for him. Accompanied by Jérôme Loubés, he presents this wine from the love of a demanding land. The shiny dress with mauve reflections is an invitation to travel. A symphony of red and black fruits is revealed on the nose while the mouth, suave and round, exhales scents of liquorice and spices reminiscent of the garrigue surrounding this parcel of northern Catalonia.
